## SURVEY METHODOLOGY

The Cato Institute 2021 Immigration and Identity National Survey was conducted by the Cato Institute in collaboration with YouGov. YouGov collected responses March 5 to 15, 2021 from 2600 Americans 18 years of age and older. These were then matched into a nationally representative sample of to produce the final dataset. The survey included additional oversamples of Latino American respondents (300), Asian American respondents (300), and White conservative respondents (200). Results have been weighted to be representative of the national adult sample. The margin of error for the survey is +/- 2.21 percentage points at the 95% level of confidence. This does not include other sources of non-sampling error, such as selection bias in panel participation or response to a particular survey.

YouGov conducted the surveys online with its proprietary Web-enabled survey software, using a method called Active Sampling. Restrictions are put in place to ensure that only the people selected and contacted by YouGov are allowed to participate.

The respondents in each survey were matched to a sampling frame on gender, age, race, education. The three additional samples were matched to sampling frames on gender, age, and education. The frame was constructed by stratified sampling from the full 2014 Pew Religion Survey sample with selection within strata by weighted sampling with replacements (using the person weights on the public use file).

Each set of matched cases were weighted to its sampling frame using propensity scores. The matched cases and the frame were combined and a logistic regression was estimated for inclusion in the frame. The propensity score function included age, gender, race/ethnicity, years of education, census region. The propensity scores were grouped into deciles of the estimated propensity score in the frame and post-stratified according to these deciles. The nationally representative weight and the Asian American and Latino American weights were then post-stratified on the 2016 Presidential vote choice, 2020 Presidential vote choice, and ideology, before all four weights were finally post-stratified on a four-way stratification of gender, four category age, four category race, and 4 category education, to produce the final weight.
